

## SIMPLE STEPS FOR BUYING BEE-SAFE PLANTS

- 1 Seek out organic plants and seeds.
  - Avoid plants grown with neonicotinoids and other similar systemic insecticides.
- Ask what steps your nursery takes to offer plants grown using pollinator-friendly pest management.



Are you planting a pollinator garden? If so, talk to your nursery about pollinator-friendly practices. Many nurseries commonly use pesticides, some harmful to bees. Take the time to let your nursery know you want plants free from harmful pesticide residues.
